- **Review of Minutes from May 18, 2017**
 - ✓ The minutes were reviewed and no changes were noted. As there was not a quorum so the vote to approve was postponed.
- **2016/2017 Data Review** – postponed.
 - ✓ CASA made a brief presentation and explained their program. They distributed a California Governor's Office of Emergency Services report along with pamphlets about their programs.
 - ✓ CASA was originally set up for victims of violent crimes. The California funded program follows the victim wherever they go. There is a hub of information and resources available regardless of the victim's location. This program is not funded through tax payer dollars but through restitutions from those convicted of a crime. The program has just been extended for three or four years.

- **Review of 2017/2018 Strategies**
 - ✓ The overview was postponed as there was no quorum. Jeff explained that the Strategies are almost identical to last years. Several programs were added last year. Solid outcomes are desired before making any changes. So far, the feedback all seems positive.
 - ✓ The transitional housing piece is out for proposals.
 - ✓ 2017/2018 proposal is not adding or deleting staff for the most part. A Consumer Assistance Worker is being added to Leadership 4 Life program.

- **Vote on 2017/2018 Strategies**
 - ✓ The vote was postponed as there was not a quorum.
 - ✓ A meeting will be scheduled in the near future to obtain the vote. A couple of possible dates are July 26th or 27th. Notification will be sent out once a date and time are selected.
