What is Recovery?



Basically, Recovery is about living well. It is about moving beyond a diagnosis. It is about defining for yourself, who you are rather than accepting how you have been defined by others. It is about creating a satisfying life of your choosing. Instead of focusing on "what is wrong with me?," Recovery focuses on WHAT IS RIGHT. Mental health recovery is a journey of healing and transformation enabling a person to live a meaningful life in their community while striving to achieve their full potential.

At the Wellness Center we know how important it is to feel as though you are a part of a community. People at the Wellness Center are always happy to see new faces, welcome others without judgment, and allow you to go as fast, or as slow, as you need to.

Peer Support: You will find friends at the Center who will encourage you, celebrate your good days, and listen to your thoughts and feelings. Each person is given a sense of belonging and receive support, while becoming a part of the community.

Respect: It is important for each of us to accept and believe in ourselves.
