Dear Parents and Students,

The California State Legislature approved an election law that allows high school students to serve as poll workers on Election Day. This special program gives students hands-on experience in the voting process. Join other high school students in the state as they discover firsthand how the American electoral process works.

In order to be a Student Poll Worker, the following must be met:

- Be at least 16 years of age
- Be a United States citizen or Legal U.S. Resident
- Be a student in good standing
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5
- Have written permission from a parent/ guardian and your school

Highly Desirable:

- Bilingual in Spanish, Chinese, Punjabi, or Hmong
- Tech Savvy

Students will be required to work from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Election Day. They will also attend a poll worker training class prior to the election. Students will be compensated with either \$130.00 or 15 community service hours.

Student Poll Worker Application

Tech Savvy and Bilingual Election Workers are Highly Desirable

- **Student Poll Worker Eligibility**
 - At least 16 years of age by the Election Date
 - Written Parental Consent (if under 18 years of age)
 - United States Citizen or Legal U.S. Resident
 - A minimum 2.5 GPA verified by a school official
- **Poll Worker Training and Compensation**
 - Election Day Stipend: \$130.00
 - Additional \$100.00 Stipend for Required Training
- **Poll Worker Hours**
 - 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Election Day
