

# PREPARING THE EXPRESS VOTE

- > This is the screen indicating that the ExpressVote has completely powered up and is ready to go.
- > Close and lock the access compartment.
- Your ExpressVote is now ready for the day!

#### NOTE:

Printing the ExpressVote ballot card does not issue a ballot to the voter.

You must first issue the ballot through the Vote Center App on the EIMS laptop, print the label, and attach the label to the back of the Poll Pad ticket.



### PRINTING EXPRESSVOTE BALLOT

The ballot issuing clerk will use the ExpressLink software to print the ballot with the appropriate precinct ballot for the voter.



### EXPRESSLINK SOFTWARE




On the "Ballot-Issuing Clerk" laptop, double click on the ExpressLink icon. If the software open and there is no Election Name, you will need to load the election information.

Choose "Browse"...go to to the C Drive to find this path:

C:>BOD

Files>BallotOnDemand\_Export.ezip. Click on load.
