

NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF MERCED
COUNTY FOR UNSECURED TAXES



Unsecured tax bills were mailed on July 29, 2022 to the addresses shown on the unsecured tax roll.

An Unsecured Tax generally refers to property that can be relocated and is not real property.

The tax is assessed against such property as business personal property/fixtures, boats and airplanes.

Failure to receive a tax bill shall not relieve the lien of taxes, nor shall it prevent penalties from being imposed by California Revenue & taxation code § 2610.5

Taxes on the unsecured tax roll as of July 29, 2022 if unpaid are delinquent August 31, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. and, thereafter, a 10% penalty attaches to them. Unpaid taxes accrue penalties of 1½% per month beginning November 1, 2022.
